





ACCOMODATIONS!








FUNDRAISING

ETC.

- PASSPORT: Must be valid 6 months past date of travel
- BACKGROUND CHECK & CHILD ABUSE CLEARANCE: 18+ please complete & send to Bold Hope
- MINORS: Anyone under 18 needs to submit a notarized approval for temporary guardianship
- There are no mandatory vaccinations required to travel to Belize



All international travelers should research the area they are visiting. Plan to call or visit your primary care physician or a travel medicine specialist at least 4–8 weeks prior to your departure. We recommend starting your research with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. After gathering information, you can then make decisions that are best for you or your family members. The CDC recommends that travelers be up to date with vaccinations common to those living in the United States, such as tetanus and measles/mumps/rubella.
